Course Name: Life Skills Math (levels 1-4)

Grade Level: 6-12

Subject Area: Mathematics

Class Goals: This class is a small environment that allows students to practice real-life math skills and develop problem solving skills for real life situations. We work on basic math skills. They develop their practical skills in measurement, calculating with money, and telling time. Students also have the opportunity to explore the concepts of earning and spending money and apply their understanding in a range of financial decision-making contexts.

Skills that are covered throughout each level:

- Number concepts
- Whole numbers
- Money skills
- time/elapsed time
- Fractions
- Decimals
- Percents
- Ratios
- Measurement
- Basic geometry
- Integers

Homework Policy/ Grading System:

- Homework in this class will be minimal, but you will be required to continue your work if it is not finished in class.
