FY22 ESSER use:

- Learning Loss:
 - Clinton Community College - J Kilburg tutoring
 - Imagine Learning - online classes
 - August summer school salaries/benefits
 - Some of our reading teacher salaries/benefits at the elementary
- Regular ESSER:
 - One partial associate's salary (17%)
 - One full-teacher salary
 - Band masks, instrument covers
 - Hand Sanitizer
 - "Challenge to Change"
 - Life Connection - SEL services

FY23 uses:

- Learning Loss:
 - Clinton Community College - J Kilburg tutoring
 - Online classes - For special circumstances
 - Potentially some of our reading teacher salaries/benefits at the elementary
- Regular:
 - Two full-teacher salaries
 - Some associate pay
 - "Challenge to Change"
 - Life Connection - SEL services
 - Misc supplies if any

FY24 uses:

- Full-Teacher Salary
- Tutoring Services
- Online Classes - Special Circumstances and Needs of Students;
Full-online enrollment based on health concerns or specific courses.
