Property Taxes DECREASING in the Bellevue CSD

It appears again that the Bellevue CSD will have a decrease in property taxes for the 7th straight year based on actions by the Bellevue CSD School Board in March. This action is scheduled to be finalized at the April Board Meeting. The school board strives to ensure the district is utilizing funds in the most effective manner and saving money whenever possible while still providing the best programs and working to provide the best facilities and learning environments for our students.

The tax rates in the Bellevue CSD are lower than nearly all nearby districts on an annual basis, and the 33-cent decrease this year will once again show this as the proposed tax rate decreases the rate to 10.5362.
