Fifty Years of Comet Football

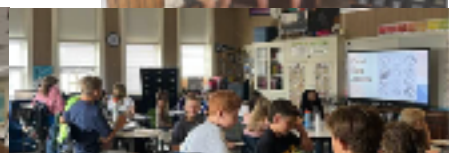
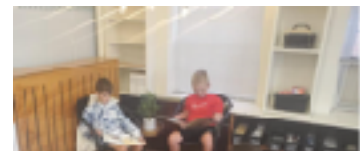
