Updated Spectator Guidelines

The Bellevue CSD has re-evaluated our spectator attendance guidelines after hosting two events last week. Our number one priority has been to do our best to keep our athletes, as well as all those in attendance safe as we continue to navigate through this school year. With that being said, the amount of people at our games has raised some concerns in regards to the amount of people we have had at the games and the lack of space for fans to socially distance. As a result, the district has decided to make the following changes to the game attendance policy for games hosted at Bellevue Schools.:

Basketball Games

- Players/participants will be allowed immediate household members or two people, NOT both.
- Players that have siblings on the team will not get two tickets per player if their household is attending the game.
- JV spectators that do not have a ticket to the varsity contests will need to leave at the conclusion of the JV contest. January 25th is a Girl JV/V, in that case JV parents can stay for the varsity game.
- Players with split families will be allowed to have both parent households attend.
- Players that are on both JV and Varsity will not get separate tickets for each, but can attend both games.
- Those with a varsity ticket will be allowed to attend both the girls and boys varsity games, but will not be allowed to watch the JV games.
- Middle School games will follow the same guidelines.

Pep Band Members

- Only parents/household members will be allowed admittance. Tickets will indicate that these are for parents and their household only and should not be given to others.
- Parents may stay for the entirety of the contest as long as the band is playing. If the band only plays for the girls game and in between games, then band parents must leave before the boys game.

Dance Team Members

- Only parents/household members will be allowed admittance to the games. Tickets will indicate that these are for parents and their household only and should not be given to others.
- Parents should only come to the game that their child performs.

Wrestling Meets

- Wrestlers/participants will be allowed immediate household members or two people, NOT both.
