

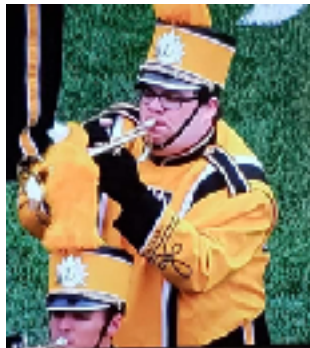
# The Weekly Comet Update
